Grant Township Residents

With the risk of COVID-19 spreading to our Township growing daily, Grant Township would ask that all residents and visitors follow State and Federal recommendations and guidelines including Shelter In Place. These general guidelines are effective for the next 30 days, subject to change as needed.

Basic personal hygiene measures:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water.
- Use hand sanitizer if soap and water are not available.
- Avoid touching your face with unwashed hands.
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when coughing or sneezing, and then throw it away.
- No handshakes or hugs.
- Avoid contact with people who are sick.
- If you are sick or not feeling well, stay home.
- Limit your exposure to public places, and use common sense if you do go out.
- Keep a minimum 6-foot distance from people.

Other precautions to limit the spread of the virus:

- The Community and Visitor centers are closed.
- The Post office will remain open. At this time access to the mail boxes will remain as it is.
- Only essential meetings will be held to conduct necessary Township Business
- If you need to meet with a Township official please call or email to setup a time to meet.
- Emails of officials can be found on the Township Website, www.granttownshipmi.org
- Anyone visiting the Township Office is asked to sanitize their hands or wash them when they arrive.
- If you attend any meetings, the 6-foot rule will be strictly enforced.

There is a need to protect those that are at risk. We will monitor the situation closely and react as reliable information becomes available.
